## In association: BG Hospitals in Germany

Since 2016, the Bergmannstrost has been part of the Group of BG Hospitals. This nationwide association encompasses all statutory accident insurance hospitals and accident treatment centres. The group includes the nine largest accident hospitals in Germany, one of them the Bergmannstrost.

The BG Hospitals are funded by professional associations and accident insurers. Statutory accident insurance clinics are non-profits, and their mission is unique in the country: To care for patients affected by occupational accidents and vocational diseases with "every available resource" as defined by the German Social Security Statute VII. In 13 facilities at 12 locations across the country, more than 12,500 employees treat nearly 550,000 patients annually.

With its 125-year history, the BG Hospital Bergmannstrost Halle is Germany's second oldest accident hospital. Upon reopening in 1997, it became one of the most modern special hospitals for accident, severe burn injury, head trauma, and spinal injury patients in Germany. On behalf of the German Statutory Accident Insurance, we treat accident victims and ill patients with state-of-the-art medical care and ensure patient rehabilitation with all suitable treatment options. Since 2010, the Bergmannstrost is a Supraregional Trauma Treatment Centre of the German Society for Trauma Surgery.

We offer the highest level of care for treatment of severe accident injuries with extremely complex and rare injury types. We focus particularly on the tight integration of cutting-edge acute care and earliest possible rehabilitation. The Bergmannstrost is breaking new ground with its cross-disciplinary approach to early rehabilitation, striving for seamless and efficient rehabilitation after an accident or illness.

The Bergmannstrost is available to patients with coverage by all health insurance plans and accident insurers.
